

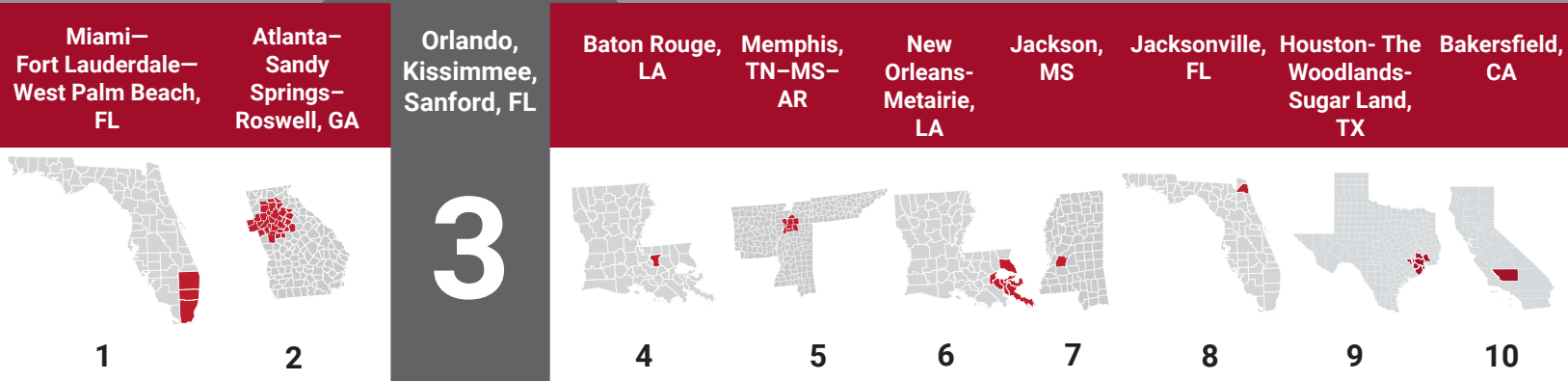
# DO YOU KNOW HIV/AIDS IN CENTRAL FLORIDA?

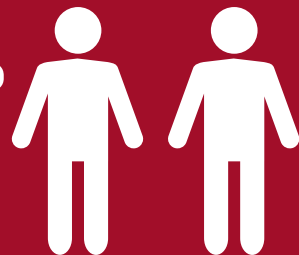
